**Subject: Taking up of NRDWP schemes as per the revised liability ceilings.**


Madam / Sir,

Please refer to para 6 of this Ministry letter No. W-11011/21/2015-Water-I (Part-I) dated 11.03.2019 stating that States would now be allowed to take up new schemes under NRDWP only when the net committed liability of all ongoing schemes under NRDWP is less than the sum of (a) amount of unspent balance and (b) 1.5 times of annual allocation & State matching share thereof at any point of time. There will be no exception except for inclusion of Swajal schemes.

2. Schemes whose work orders are issued and accordingly updated in the system, alone will be considered for calculating States liability as on date. Schemes which are approved in SLSSC but work order not issued are not part of the liability as on date.

3. If a State becomes ineligible for taking up new schemes, State must not do the tendering process. As these schemes will not be allowed for entering into format C-39 and for booking of expenditure under NRDWP Coverage & JE-AES components. However, State is free to take it up as a purely State funded scheme.
