Sub: Mismatch of list of schemes between IMIS and status of Drinking Water Supply under PHED website

He may be aware that Govt. of India has directed to rectify the list of schemes in IMIS in a time bound manner. In this respect please refer to the minutes of the meeting held at New Town on 07.04.2017 already available in the PHED website vide this office Memo No. 4382/MC/08/2015, dated 24.04.2017.

It was further directed in the meeting that the list of schemes available in the PHED website should strictly match with the IMIs. However, it is observed that many of the divisions has not complied the same and a table showing the mismatch of the scheme listed in PHED website with the IMIS is enclosed as annexure-I for his ready reference.

He is once again requested to go through the mismatch data as per the enclosed list and in order to set right the mismatch data following clarification are listed below.

1. The status of Commissioned schemes having physical progress close to 100% are ongoing in the IMIS since additional funds are required to complete those schemes. However, such schemes are not included in the list of ongoing schemes in the PHED website.
2. In order to accommodate those schemes, provisions will be made in PHED website separately.
3. Additional provisions will be made for listing of Augmentation/Rejuvenation/other types of schemes in PHED website.
4. A separate column for capturing physical progress as well as financial progress for a particular scheme will be available in the PHED website.
5. **All such provisions will be available from April 2017 which can be updated from the month of May, 2017.**

It is once again reiterated that Drinking Water Supply Status in PHED website should be regularly updated by the 10 of every month and the signed hard copy of the same should be sent to the undersigned by 15th of every month.

Please treat this as most urgent.
