Referring to the subject mentioned above and the previous communications from the undersigned, this is to be noted that, he was requested to prepare a Detail Project Report (DPR) to take up the repairing work of the dysfunctional water sources in different schools in his district as per the DISE Data (2016-17). It was decided in the meeting held on 08/06/2017, the DPR on 'Repairing of dysfunctional water sources in schools' in his district will be submitted by all the concerned divisions within the 15<sup>th</sup> June, 2017. However, the Head Quarters Office is yet to receive any DPR from his end.

Therefore, he is further requested to execute the detail survey and take up the repairing work forthwith and prepare and submit the DPR within the 27<sup>th</sup> June, 2017.

This may be treated as extremely urgent.



He may be aware that as per DISE Data (2016-17) some Primary Schools / Upper Primary Schools / SSKs / MSKs are still without any drinking water source. A summary report of source less schools is enclosed as Annexure-I. In this regard, a detailed list has already been circulated by this Office Memo No. 6428-6444/MC/13/15 Dated, Kolkata, the 02.06.2017. Further, in this regard, a meeting was held on 8<sup>th</sup> June, 2017 wherein the following decisions were taken –

- 1) Execute a detail survey of the source less schools & prepare a DPR which is to be submitted latest by 15<sup>th</sup> June, 2017. The said DPR will be forwarded to the School Education Department for necessary funding.
- 2) Wherever piped water supply (PWS) is available, connection should be made through existing PWS with provision of storage tank etc. within the school premises.
- 3) If any tender / work order has already been issued for providing water sources in the listed source less schools, then work should be taken up immediately as per the existing work order.
- 4) Wherever there is water quality problem, necessary treatment methodology should be considered.
- 5) A detailed documentation of the work done should be done through Mobile App and same should be visible on a Dashboard.
- 6) Before taking up the work, necessary consultation with the school / district authorities should be made with regard to future maintenance of the installed water sources.  
Since Gram Panchayat (GP) / Village Water & Sanitation Committee (VWSC) are already maintaining the hand pump tube wells within a particular GP, therefore, the same methodology for Operation & Maintenance (O&M) of hand pump tube wells should be adopted for maintaining the water sources in the schools.
- 7) Training / capacity building for O&M of water facilities in the schools may be extended from PHE Department.

He is therefore requested to take immediate action on the above said issues.



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
**Sub :** Repairing of dysfunctional water sources in schools

He may be aware that as per DISE Data (2016-17) a large number of water sources in Primary Schools / Upper Primary Schools / SSKs / MSKs are dysfunctional. A district-wise summary report of schools having dysfunctional water sources is enclosed as **Annexure-I**. The detailed list is being sent through e-mail. In this regard, a detailed list has already been circulated by this Office Memo No. 6428-6444/MC/13/15 Dated, Kolkata, the 02.06.2017. Further, in this regard, a meeting was held on 8<sup>th</sup> June, 2017 wherein the following decisions were taken -

- 1) Execute a detail survey & take up the repairing work forthwith and also prepare a DPR which will be forwarded to the School Education Department for necessary funding.
- 2) In case of any water quality problem, necessary water treatment required for the water source should be suggested in the DPR.
- 3) A detailed documentation of the repairing work done should be done through a Mobile App and same should be visible on a web based Dashboard.
- 4) The repairing work should be done as a one-time effort and any further repairing work will be done by the respective Village Water & Sanitation Committee (VWSC) / Gram Panchayat (GP) / School authority.
- 5) Necessary training / capacity building of plumbers or any identified personnel from VWSC / School authority will be extended by PHE Department.

He is therefore requested to take immediate action on the above said issues.
