

Minutes of the meeting held on 1st June, 2018 to review the progress in connection with the installation, commissioning and O&M of Standalone Community Purification Plants



The meeting was chaired by Sri Animesh Bhattacharya, Director, WSSO, PHE Department, Govt. of West Bengal and welcomed all members and initiated the discussion.

Sri Bhattacharya appreciated the fact that some of the Divisions have taken appropriate steps in ensuring that action plan discussed in the last meeting (held on 1st January, 2018) has been put to practice. Following are some additional suggestions proposed by the participating officials:

1. Water quality test reports from all the commissioned CPPs should be uploaded in the PHED dashboard on a regular basis.
2. The CPPs must be declared as commissioned only after satisfactory performance evaluation for consecutive 7 days. Previous orders issued by WSSO in this regard must be followed.
3. All information regarding replacement of media with date in the CPPs should also be uploaded in the dashboard. Necessary provision in this regard will have to be made in the dashboard by the concerned agency.
4. Video clips showing successful operation of the CPPs must be uploaded in the dashboard in the allotted slots, within 1 month.
5. Details regarding handing over of the commissioned CPPs to the GP/VWSC/SHG should be uploaded in the dashboard.
6. Facilitators can be asked to collect water samples (both raw and treated water) from the CPPs for water quality testing in laboratories, and the extra remuneration for this purpose can be given by PHED.
7. Executive engineers, along with the concerning agencies should plan for joint visits to the CPPs on a monthly basis to review the status and efficiency of the CPPs in providing arsenic free drinking water. They may also ask the consultants at WSSO to join them in their field visits.
8. Monthly meetings to discuss the performance evaluation of the CPPs must be conducted that would involve officials from the PHED and the agencies entrusted with the O&M of the CPPs.
9. Poor performance of commissioned CPPs should be identified and communicated to the concerned agency for rectification.
