
**ORDER**

The Terms and Reference of the committee may be as follows:-

1. To prepare a draft bidding document for implementation of FHTC with the following considerations:
  - i. The district wise target of FHTC that has to be achieved during the FY 2020- 21 should be considered as the volume of the work towards fixing up of eligibility criteria and other parameter as deemed necessary.
  - ii. The objective is to invite tenders in the form of packages centrally through a Circle/ Division so that the Executive Engineers are relieved from inviting multiple tenders and focus more on the field work. The Executive Engineers should only be responsible to enter into contract agreement with the selected bidders and award the contracts.
  - iii. The bid should aim towards involvement of maximum no. of bidders within the district so that the targets are achieved within the remaining period of current financial year.
  - iv. The standard bid document should indicate the broad contours of the BOQ put to tender based on the published SOR of PHED or other Govt. Departments.
  - v. The award of work may be linked with the performance of the bidders to instil a sense of competitiveness within the bidders.
  - vi. Any other policy/ criteria that would speed up the work should also be suggested.
2. The draft bidding document should be submitted within 15 days from the date of constitution of the committee.




