Sreshtha Jal Parikhagar Puraskar

Background

West Bengal has the largest decentralized network of rural water testing laboratories (217 nos) established by Public Health Engineering Department (PHED), under National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP), in the country. These laboratories as mandated under the NRDWP guidelines, test water samples collected from public drinking water sources across the State.

Our robust water quality monitoring mechanism and well equipped laboratories have been appreciated time and again by the Govt. of India. This was only possible due to the dedicated and sincere efforts of our laboratory staff and facilitators.

In order to ensure more reliability and confidence in the quality of data generated in these laboratories, the Department organizes various training programmes for the laboratory personnel regularly.

Under this backdrop, the Department has now decided to assess the performance of these laboratories based on relevant evaluation indicators, to identify and address gaps, thereby giving the laboratories an opportunity to further improve their performance.

PHED with the support from UNICEF has developed a laboratory assessment guideline, which pertains to a two tier assessment of the laboratories. All laboratories are assessed every quarter by the District Assessment Team. Short listed laboratories based on their scores are then assessed by an academic institute and based on the final assessment report, these laboratories are ranked accordingly.

In the context of the State and National priority on Water, the event is strategic as West Bengal is the first State in the country to organize an award event to acknowledge the contribution and efforts of the rural water testing laboratories.

In the context to the above, the "***Sreshtha Jal Parikhagar Puraskar Ceremony 2019***" is being organized on **10 July 2019** at **Biswa Bangla Convention Centre**, New Town, Kolkata, to felicitate the best laboratories in the State.
