He had been requested vide letter under reference (copy enclosed) to ensure uniformity with respect to number of water tests among the laboratories under his jurisdiction by necessary modification of jurisdiction with respect to the GPs under the laboratories. Sub: Modification of Gram Panchayat wise Laboratory jurisdiction for ensuring uniformity in testing of water samples

He may be aware that facilitators have been collecting water samples from various Gram Panchayats as per the G.P. wise jurisdiction of the laboratories. The monthly target related to number of water samples to be tested for each laboratory is also predefined which is 250. However it has been observed that though some laboratories are accomplishing water tests with respect to the monthly targets, but due to receiving of excess water samples from higher number Gram Panchayats as per their jurisdiction, they are required to test samples beyond their stipulated targets.

On the other hand it is also observed that some laboratories are unable to complete their monthly targets as they are receiving less water samples due to lesser number of G.Ps within their jurisdiction. As a result, the uniformity with respect to the monthly testing of water samples is not being achieved in several laboratories.

The lists of laboratories along with the no. of GPs under the jurisdiction of each laboratory and stipulated monthly target considering 20 samples from each GP, have been listed under **Annexure I**. It is observed from the list that there is significant nos. of laboratories testing samples less than 250 and some of the laboratories are also testing no. of samples much greater than 250.

Considering the facts as stated above he is hence requested to ensure uniformity with respect to number of water tests among the laboratories under his jurisdiction by necessary modification of jurisdiction with respect to the G.Ps. under the laboratories, so that 250-300 numbers of water samples may be tested in each laboratory every month.

The modified G.P. jurisdiction of the labs may please be completed by 20th June '2019 with an intimation of the revised jurisdiction to this office.


