Sub: Monitoring of Piped Water Supply Scheme (PWSS) samples

This has reference to the above memo no. wherein he had been requested to accomplish the following works for facilitating collection of water samples for the Piped Water Supply Schemes from pump houses & stand posts.

1. Marking of wall of each pump house in red with zone number and tubewell number for ease of identification of the tubewell by the collectors.
2. Earmarking 2 nos. of farthest street standposts with labeling for collection of water samples from those street standposts only.
3. Exploring other means to collect water samples from PWSS through Sampling Assistants or Pump Operators/Valve Operators in event of facilitators not collecting water samples on a regular basis.

It has been observed that only Executive Engineer, Alipur Division has sent the current status report for the stated works in PWS Schemes under his jurisdiction. The status regarding receipt of hard copy test report of PWSS as sought vide memo no PHE/WSSO/112/(Pt.-XVIII)/1210-1238 dated 20/05/2019 under reference is enclosed herewith as ready reference. Several divisions as listed in *Annexure I* (enclosed herewith) are yet to send the water quality reports of PWSS in a manner as sought vide the said memo no.

In this regard, he is requested to furnish hard copies of the test results in appropriate format along with mailing of the same in MS-Excel format in smu@wbphed.gov.in, as was enclosed in memo no PHE/WSSO/112/(Pt.-XVIII)/1210-1238 dated 20/05/2019, on regular basis henceforth within 7th of every month. Also the status report regarding accomplishment of works as per serial no. 1, 2 & 3 above may please be furnished also in appropriate format (enclosed with Memo No. PHE/WSSO/112/(Pt.-XVIII)/1873-1901 dated 25/07/2019).
